## Secure File Transfer

- **A common way to transfer files is with FTP/SFTP**

- **Allows you to “drag and drop” as oppose to one-at-a-time file upload**

- **Find/install a FTP client**
  - **PC – WinSCP**
  - **Mac – Fugu/Cyberduck**
- **Find the ftp address for your host**
